- Traditional/Classic** – This style has a lot of wood detail in furnishings and floorings. This sophisticated style has furnishings such as wing-back chairs, antique wooden tables and sofas that are upholstered in cozy velvets or chenilles.



- Modern/Urban** – These interiors tend to feature very streamlined or minimalistic design. The architectural elements tend to place importance on functionality and sparseness; color schemes tend to be monochromatic. This style is conducive to smaller living spaces.



- Modern Rustic/Cottage Chic** – This style has farmhouse influences in a modern application. Natural elements such as faded woods and tumbled stone mixed with monochromatic beiges and neutral tones bring in a rustic feeling. Details may include industrial steel or tin fixtures. Soft furnishings tend to be in felt, washed linens, and cable knit wools.



- Contemporary/Transitional** – This is a softer approach to 'modern' but still has clean lines. Surfaces are generally lacquered, glass or metal. Limited, solid colors keep this look clean. Practical fabrics such as leathers and faux suede's are often used. Splashes of color in artwork and accessories are typical of this style, and are elegant without being ornate. The result is a very beautiful less formal space.



- Eclectic/Bohemian** – This style often has furnishings or accessories from other countries or cultures. While there may be kiln rugs or pottery, there may also be some contemporary furniture. This style has a well-travelled, educated feel but is quite original in its sensibility. Dramatic colors and textures are typical of this style.
